Minimum Age Requirements

All volunteers must be a minimum of 21 years of age before the event to volunteer. Photo ID will be checked during the check-in process, so don't forget to grab it as you head out the door!

Name Tag/Clothing

Come as you are, the more festive the better of course. At check-in, you will receive a nametag along with a volunteer wristband.

Parking

We ask all volunteers to park at the St. Mark's Treasurer House, 805 North St. Beaumont, Texas. It is a half a block from the Event. Walk across the United Way parking lot to access the Event on N. Pearl.

Check-In

There will be a volunteer check-in area to the right of the Event entrance inside the youth room attached to the gym. If you were a volunteer in past years, it is the same room you have always checked-in at.

Responsibilities

Many volunteers will be assigned to a specific area and will be pouring delicious beer during the Event. You will be serving a 2 oz. beer samples to patrons. There is a line on the glass indicating the amount to pour. A high level of professionalism is required, and knowledge of beer being served is always welcomed. Other volunteers may be helping with ticketing entrances, running ice, set-up, or break down. However, we are a team and appreciate your willingness to help wherever and whenever needed throughout the duration of the Event. Please be courteous and helpful to all participants and offer any assistance to those with special needs.

On-Duty Rules

1. Do NOT pour to anyone without a wristband!
2. There should not be anyone at the Event that does not have a wristband. If you see someone who is not wearing a wristband, please let a committee member or security personnel know immediately.
3. If you serve to anyone without a wristband, legal action may be taken. So please, be aware. We are checking ID's at the door. Everyone who is of age will have a wristband.
4. Pour to the 2 oz. line – no more. It is a Texas law for beer tasting.
5. Please do not drink while poring. Tasting is not allowed during this time according to Texas State Law. However, when your shift is over you are free to taste.
6. Please do NOT dump ice on the ground or in the grass outside. The ice will kill the grass.
7. If there are unopened cases, please be sure they do not get wet or damaged. Please do not open any new cases after 5:30pm
8. At 5:45 pm, the announcer will note there will be 15 minutes until the end of poring.
9. At 6:00 pm, once pouring is over, please remain at your booth and be sure any remaining beer is stacked and no one takes it.
10. Please fold up tables at your location as well. To help with the breakdown process.
